

## Overview - Retirement Individual Development Account (IDA)

**Open to:** Oregon Residents not eligible for employer sponsored retirement accounts. Due to IRS regulations, participants must earn wages greater than \$6000 per year to transfer funds to IRA accounts.

**Savings Duration:** 6-24 months

**Match Rate:** 5:1

**Max Savings/Match:** Total \$12,000

Save \$1000, matched with \$5000 per year up to 2 years

**Funds can be used for:**

- Starting or adding funds to Roth or Traditional IRA accounts when you are not eligible for employer sponsored retirement
- IRAs with Oregon Saves, private investment brokerages or financial institutions including credit unions or banks

### Income Eligibility Guidelines

Multnomah, Washington & Clackamas counties. Ask for guidelines for other Oregon counties.

1 person household: \$59,650

2 person household: \$68,200

3 person household: \$76,700

4 person household: \$85,200

TANF/SNAP/WIC/LIHEAP/LIHTC/Public Housing/SSI/Refugee Cash Assistance recipients & most Section 8 housing may automatically meet income guidelines\*

### Household Net Worth Eligibility:

- Household net worth cannot exceed \$20,000
- Value of 1st vehicle, 1st home and up to \$120,000 retirement is excluded

### Program Requirements:

- **Financial Education:** Applicants must take a financial wellness workshop and complete a monthly budget with financial coach to demonstrate ability to save
- **Asset Specific Education:** Participants must complete at least 6 hours retirement education
- **IDA Intake:** Participant meets with IDA Specialist to review application & supporting documents, pay \$25 application fee and complete a savings and personal development plan
